In accordance with section 86 of the Local Electoral Act 2001, I hereby declare the result for the Abolition Poll held on Saturday 19th November 2005.

I confirm that the official result was determined after the scrutiny of the roll was completed, the validity of all special votes was determined and all valid votes were counted.

Votes cast For the Proposal	3,341
Votes cast Against the Proposal	2,279
Informal voting documents	0
Blank voting documents	4

The majority of those electors in Banks Peninsula District who voted in the Poll voted **FOR** the Proposal.

I therefore declare that the proposal to abolish the Banks Peninsula District and include it in Christchurch City was CARRIED.

The voting return percentage was 76.45%.
