PROPOSAL FOR TRANSFER OF PART OF RODNEY DISTRICT TO NORTH SHORE CITY

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Local Government Commission has received a proposal for the transfer of part of Rodney District to North Shore City. The proposal was initiated by a petition of 142 Rodney District electors living in the Okura area. The proposal was referred to the Commission for consideration and a decision by the Rodney District Council and the North Shore City Council in accordance with clause 10(2) of Schedule 3 of the Local Government Act 2002.

The area proposed to be transferred comprises meshblocks 0175816, 0176102, 0176101, and 0176003. The map of the area included with the petition can be viewed at the Commission's website: www.lgc.govt.nz.

Any person or organisation wishing to make a submission to the Commission on the proposal may do so by Tuesday 21 March 2006.

Submissions may be made on any matter relevant to the proposal, including

- whether or not the proposal should proceed; and
- whether some modification or variation of the proposal should be adopted.
