PROPOSAL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A ROTORUA LAKES COMMUNITY

The Local Government Commission has received an appeal against the decision of the Rotorua District Council to not establish a Rotorua Lakes Community.

The proposal was initiated by a petition of electors in the Rotorua Lakes area. A map showing the area of the proposed community is available from the Commission.

Under the Local Government Act 2002 the Commission is now required to determine whether or not the proposed community should be constituted.

To assist its consideration of this matter, the Commission invites public submissions on the proposal. Written submissions should be forwarded to the Commission by 24 March 2006. Submissions can also be recorded on the Commission's website: www.lgc.govt.nz

Submitters are asked to provide a contact address and daytime telephone/fax number, and to state in their submission whether they would wish to appear before the Commission at any hearing held by it on the proposal.

Submitters should note that it is the policy of the Commission to make submissions publicly available on request.
