#### **Decision on the representation arrangements for the local election of the South Wairarapa District Council to be held 13 October 2007**

The Local Government Commission today announced its decision on the representation arrangements for the South Wairarapa District at the next local election on 13 October 2007, as follows:

- The boundaries of the Greytown Ward will remain unchanged;
- The boundary between the Featherston and Martinborough Wards will be shifted from the Ruamahanga River to the Tauherenikau River.
- The Council will comprise the Mayor and 9 members, elected as follows -

Ward	Members elected from the Ward
Featherston	3
Greytown	3
Martinborough	3

- The Featherston, Greytown, and Martinborough Community Boards will be retained. Each community board will comprise 4 elected members and 2 appointed members. The boundaries of the communities will be the same as the boundaries of the Featherston, Greytown, and Martinborough Wards.

The Commission's decision confirms the South Wairarapa District Council's final representation review proposal.
