

Auckland boundary determinations – Summary of changes

Wards

- 12 wards increased to 13 wards (for electing the 20 councillors) by splitting the proposed 2 member Orakei-Maungakiekie Ward into two single member wards (Ōrākei and Maungakiekie Wards)
- Wards are now closer to the fair representation requirement of the Act (ie are closer to +/-10% range of average population per member)
- Boundary changes including:
 - all Mt Eden and Kingsland communities in Albert-Eden-Roskill Ward
 - all Glen Eden in Waitakere Ward
 - West Harbour/Hobsonville/Whenuapai moved to Albany Ward
 - Otahuhu moved to Manukau Ward

Local Boards

- Number of boards increased from 19 to 21
- Two largest boards split into two:
 - Proposed Hibiscus-Albany-East Coast Bays Local Board now Hibiscus and Bays Local Board and Upper Harbour Local Board
 - Proposed Waitakere Local Board now Henderson-Massey Local Board and Waitakere Ranges Local Board
- Some changes to membership of boards (all between 5 and 9 members) to achieve more equal representation ratios
- 7 of the 21 board areas have electoral subdivisions
- Separate Wellsford subdivision in Rodney Local Board

Boundaries of Auckland

- Some minor changes to the southern boundary (including all Kariotahi Beach and Paparimu areas included in Auckland)
- Proposed northern boundary confirmed
