



## LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION

### PROPOSAL FOR TRANSFER OF PART OF TARARUA DISTRICT TO PALMERSTON NORTH CITY

#### CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Local Government Commission has received a proposal for the transfer of part of Tararua District to Palmerston North City. The proposal was initiated by a petition of Tararua District electors residing in the Woodville area. The proposal was referred to the Commission for consideration and decision by the Tararua District Council and the Palmerston North City Council in accordance with clause 10(2) of Schedule 3 of the Local Government Act 2002.

The area proposed to transfer comprises meshblocks 1543500, 1543600, 1543800, 1543900, 1540500, 1540600, 1540700, 1540800, 1540900, 1541000, 1541100, 1541200, 1541300, 1541400, 1541500, 1541600, 1541700, 1541800, 1541900, 1542000, 1542100, 1542200, 1542300 and 1542400 - covering the Woodville township and an area of land to the north and west of the township. Any person or organisation wishing to make a submission to the Commission on the proposal may do so by Friday, 29 July 2005.
